Your Complete Guide to Traveling with Hearing Aids

Before You Leave

- Schedule a pre-travel hearing aid checkup
- Pack your carry-on kit (aids, charger, drying kit)
- Print a copy of your latest hearing test
- Save clinic contact info in your phone

What to Pack in Your Carry-On

- Hearing aids (always on you)
- Charger + power cable
- Extra batteries (if applicable)
- Domes, wax guards, cleaning tools
- Portable drying kit or dehumidifier
- Power adapter (if traveling internationally)
- Backup pair of hearing aids (if you have them)

Protect Against Weather & Humidity

- Hearing aid drying kit
- Protective case
- Small umbrella or hat for sudden rain

During Travel

- Keep hearing aids on at security (TSA-approved)
- Use them during flights for announcements
- Store in travel case when not wearing

At Your Destination

- Use drying kit nightly
- Clean domes and guards regularly
- Store in a safe spot when swimming or showering
